He is co-author of two books, as well as numerous articles in professional publications.

He is also a corporate director of CSX Corporation (NYSE:CSX), PSS World Medical, Inc. (NASDAQ:PSSI) and ACIG Insurance Company, a private A-VIII rated insurance carrier.

In terms of civic activities, Steve serves as Chairman of the Florida Chamber of Commerce, Vice Chairman of the Florida Council of 100 and is a trustee for St. John's University.
