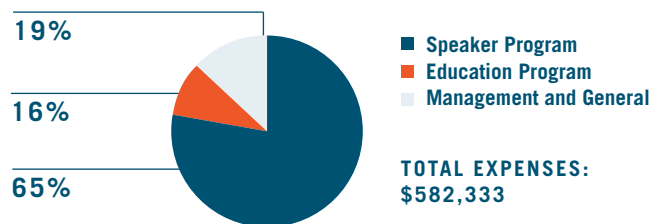

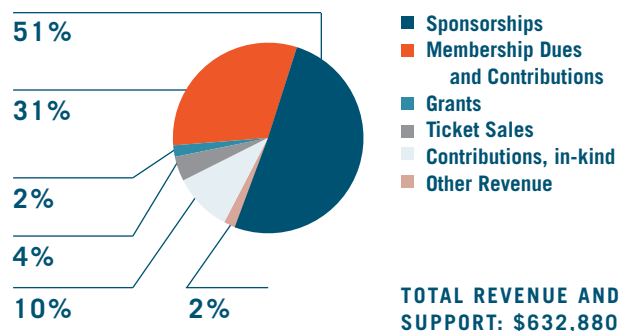
Great Decisions High School Student Interaction with
Peter W. Singer

- Thirteen high schools participated in **Great Decisions**.
- **Student Interactions** were held with Peter Singer, Ambassador Dennis Ross and Bob Woodward.
- The **Admiral Jonathan T. Howe Academic WorldQuest** attracted 44 teams from 19 high schools and the winning team from **Stanton** competed in the national competition.
- With **Admiral Howe** and **Ambassador Soderberg** acting as U.S. Presidents, the **International Crisis Management Exercise** engaged 42 students in responding to the ongoing crisis in Syria.
- The **Ambassador Marilyn McAfee Scholarship** was awarded to **Sharria Wilson**, a sophomore at Florida State College at Jacksonville.
- The **Overseas Teacher Enrichment Program** included a teacher workshop, a two-week study tour in Turkey for three teachers and a community education program.
